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Terms and Conditions – Blessed Trinity 2010/2011

General

The terms and conditions set forth in this agreement are for student transportation services provided by Pendergrass Charters Inc. (carrier) to the client (i.e. families of Blessed Trinity). This agreement is solely between the client and Pendergrass Charters Inc. for the full school year at the stated fee and any inquiries, concerns, or suggestions should be directed to the carrier.

Routes and Route Changes

The carrier will make every effort to operate routes according to schedule; however, delays may occur due to circumstances beyond the carrier's control (i.e. weather, traffic, mechanical reasons, or students being released late from school). The carrier will be available 24 hours, 7 days a week for current route information.

Additionally, the carrier may amend schedules and/or routes to adjust for varying traffic conditions, route enhancements, or school schedule changes. The carrier will review such changes with client to maintain smooth operations.

Weather

Clients should contact 404-210-8852 or 404-277-8306 (after hours) to check the status of routes because the carrier may delay and/or cancel routes due to hazardous weather, even if school is open. The carrier must consider safe operations for its school buses and motorcoaches as safety is our primary concern regarding the transportation of our clients.

Registration

The carrier will honor registrations on a first come, first served basis. Registration forms can be emailed or faxed and payments should arrive within 7 days of either transmission, otherwise, registration is incomplete and space is not reserved. If a route is not available upon receipt of registration form, the carrier will immediately notify client and client will then be able to select another route, be placed on a waiting list, or discontinue registration at that time.

Conditional Registration & Refunds

In the event a student is not accepted by the school, customer must notify the carrier within 10 days of notice from the school regarding such decision in order to receive a full refund. In appropriate cases when time permits, advance notice should be given to carrier that registration is subject to student's acceptance by the school and in such cases that the student is not accepted, a full refund will be issued.

Cancellation of services by client before the first day of classes for any reason other than the student's non-acceptance will forfeit 25% of any paid fees. The annual agreement will be enforced after the start of classes. No refunds will be made available after this point unless the carrier cancels a route before classes start, which would allow a full refund of fees paid or if the carrier cancels a route after the start of classes, which would allow a prorated refund.

Service Period and Dismissal Times

The carrier will provide transportation service from the first to the last day of classes. The carrier offers earlier departures from school only on dates in which the dismissal time for the entire school is earlier; if selected grades are dismissed early, then the carrier's schedule will not change in order to accommodate all student riders.

Guest Riders

Students may not bring unregistered guests on school buses or motorcoaches for any reason. Please contact the carrier with any concerns.

Damage to Property & Untimely Payments

Parent(s) of student riders will be responsible for damages to vehicles caused by the student's inappropriate behavior and will be charged parts and labor for repair. The carrier may suspend service due to late payment.

Lost Items

The carrier is not responsible for items left on vehicles; however, we will make our best effort to locate such items.

Fuel Surcharge

Fuel surcharge may be applied to clients if fuel costs increase, at any time during the year, by more than 30% from the average gas price as of August 2010. Surcharge will not exceed \$75 per student.

Conduct

The carrier may suspend or discontinue service due to a student's serious violation of School Bus Rules. School Bus Rules will be distributed before the first day of classes. Restoration of riding privileges will be done after parental acknowledgment is completed with an endorsement on the suspension notice which will be emailed or mailed directly to the parent(s). This form should be returned to carrier via fax, mail, or email (with electronic signature).
